

CENTENNIAL PARK MULTI SPORT BOX

The Multi Sport Box is a state-of-the-art covered open-air facility designed for a variety of sports including lacrosse, pickleball and ball hockey, allowing accessible programming for all ages.

FEATURES

- 17,000 square feet of acrylic-coated asphalt surface with markings for lacrosse, ball hockey, and four pickleball courts. The surface has a gritty texture similar to outdoor tennis courts.
- Dasher boards with chain-link fencing above
- Players benches and penalty box
- Digital scoreboard and shot clocks
- LED lighting in covered areas
- Bleachers and accessible spectator seating

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Do I need a reservation to use the space?

No reservation needed—walk-up use is welcome! Programs and bookings take priority. Open and lit daily from 7 AM to 10 PM.

How can I check availability?

Can I book a single session?

Currently, priority is given to programs, tournaments, and recurring bookings (minimum 4 weekly or bi-weekly sessions). Single-session bookings will be available later in Fall 2025 via the website.

What equipment is available?

Nets for ball hockey, lacrosse, and pickleball are provided. All nets are stored behind the box; pickleball nets are in an unlocked deck-style storage box.

What activities are permitted?

Allowed:

- Sports (lacrosse, ball hockey, pickleball, soccer, etc.)
- Bicycles, inline/roller skates, skateboards with rubber wheels

Not allowed:

- E-bikes, e-scooters, or other motorized devices (except mobility aids)
- Dogs or animals (except certified guide/assistance animals)
- Food or drink on the surface (water only)

Will there be drop-in or registered programs?

Yes! Check our website for updates on programs and community events.

Are there washrooms on-site?

Yes, located in the Fieldhouse.

Is there an AED on-site?

Yes, inside the entrance area of the men's washroom in the Fieldhouse.

Is there a water fountain?

Yes, seasonally available on the east side of the Fieldhouse near the ball diamond. Please bring a filled water bottle.

How do I enter/exit the Sport Box?

Doors are located around the perimeter.

- From outside: lift the metal latch to open
- From inside: press the white button along the blue edge of the door

Do I need insurance to rent the facility?

Yes. Insurance can be arranged through your provider or via InstantRisk. Details are provided upon booking confirmation. One certificate covering the booking and all participants is sufficient.
