



Art Display Programs at Panorama Recreation & Greenglade Community Centres

About the Exhibition Program

Exhibition spaces are available at Panorama Recreation and Greenglade Community Centres on a rotating basis. Space at Panorama Recreation can accommodate paintings, drawings/sketches, photography or other hangable pieces. Space at Greenglade can accommodate three-dimensional sculptural pieces.

Exhibitions are typically two months in duration. Following submission, applications are reviewed by a committee and artists scheduled. Artists will be notified of their scheduled display month(s) once applications reviewed.

Terms and Conditions

1. Once applications are reviewed, applicants will be notified of a decision. Successful applicants for exhibition will receive a confirmation with details on exhibit location, and dates/times for installation and take down. Exhibition Information and Guidelines will be provided.
2. Artists must ensure their artwork and display materials are “exhibit ready” before arriving for installation. There is no exhibit preparation area at Panorama Recreation or Greenglade.
3. It will be the responsibility of the artist to assist centre staff with set up and take down of their own exhibition following the guidelines provided. Installation must take place during the arranged time when staff are on site. Artists will use the provided exhibition hanging wires and may not mark the walls.
4. Artists must prepare their own exhibit materials (labels, artist statement, and/or exhibit poster). Artists will be asked to remove any presentation materials that do not follow guidelines.
5. Sales will not be facilitated by the centre. If your work is for sale, please clearly indicate a price adjacent to each piece and a method of contact for purchase inquiries. Centre staff will direct inquiring public to contact the artist directly.
6. The applicant agrees to assume responsibility for any damage or loss to their display and agrees to indemnify Panorama Recreation for any claims arising as a result of their activities associated with the art display.
7. Panorama Recreation and Greenglade Community Centres are welcoming, public spaces therefore, exhibitions should be appropriate for all ages and respectful of diverse cultures and beliefs. Works containing profanity, nudity, violence or content that may be considered disturbing to some audiences are not considered appropriate for these spaces. Panorama Recreation reserves the right to remove of any works on display that are determined to not meet this requirement.
